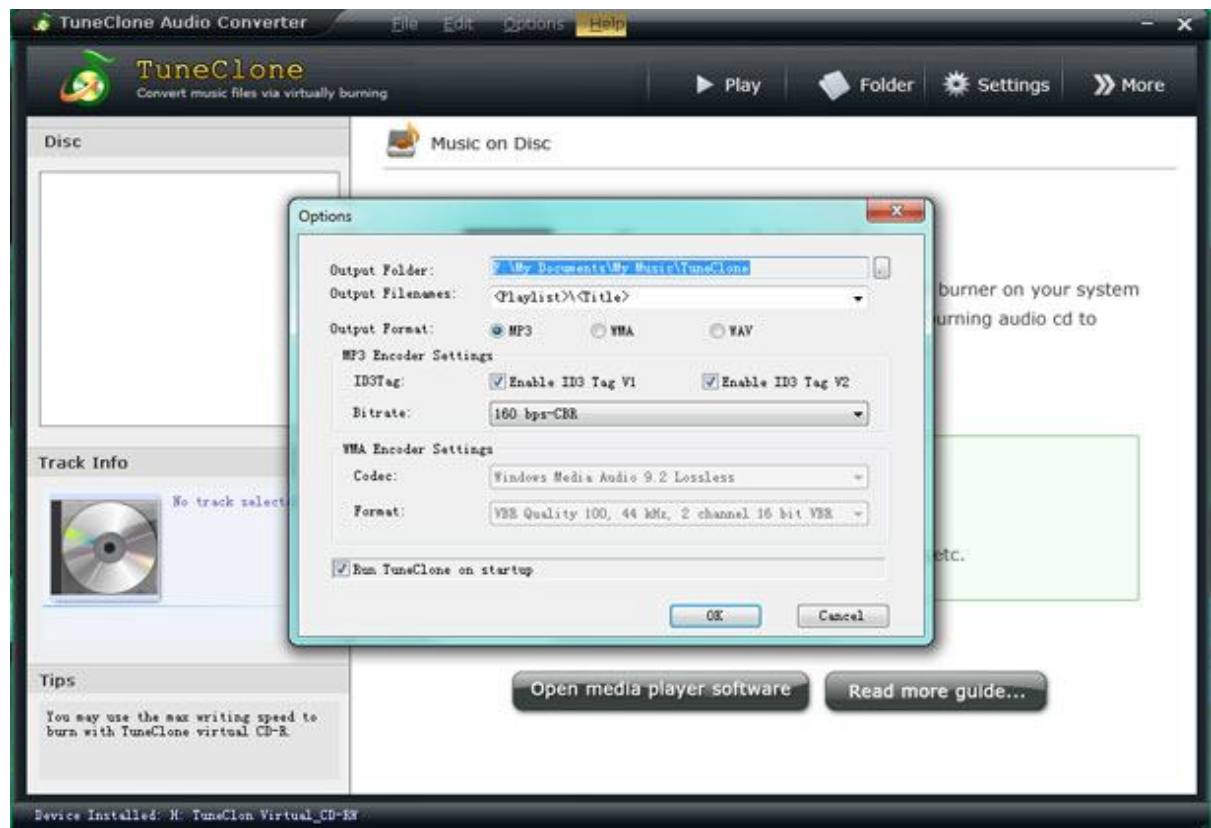


## Add iTunes Music to Slideshow as Background Music

If you are creating a photo DVD slideshow and want to add iTunes songs (m4p/aac/m4a) as the background music, you will be faced with the nasty DRM issue.

One way to resolve it is to burn iTunes DRM music tracks to an audio CD and rip it back as MP3. Then you will be able to import the output MP3 files into the slideshow and use them as the background music. However, it is a waste of CD discs if you have lots of music tracks needed to be burned and re-ripped.

Another way is to go and download [TuneClone Audio Converter](#) to help you easily and quickly convert iTunes music to mp3 via virtual CD burning. There is no need for CD discs and it fully supports batch conversion. The original music tracks in your iTunes library will be kept intact. And the meta information of the music will be well preserved.
